**Transcript:**

Dear Sir,

We have paid Mad[ame] Des Combes Liv[re]s 2960 as per enclosed receipt of y<sup>e</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> of this month & for our reimbursement drawn on you at 31 July £151 7s 6d AC y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> of this month p[aya]ble in 102 days which will fall due y<sup>e</sup> 16<sup>th</sup> of this month.

Should you not be in town on that day you will be so good to leave orders with y<sup>e</sup> People of your house where y<sup>e</sup> Bill will be paid for you.

We return you Mrs Garrick's Life Certificate, which she has forgot to Sign.

She will be So good to do It & as soon as we have received it back we Shall receive her annuity & send your amount.
